### It's free and easy



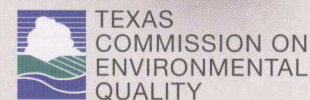
Texans now have a free and easy way to recycle unwanted personal computers. Thanks to a 2008 state law, computer manufacturers are responsible for recycling the following:

- desktop and laptop computers
- monitors (display devices without a tuner)
- the accompanying keyboard and mouse made by the same manufacturer

Note: This program applies to personal and home-business computer equipment only. Manufacturers are responsible for recycling only their own brands.
