

**Sworn Statement
of
Candidate's Eligibility**

Each Candidate applying for or being appointed to any office of the Ingleside City Council shall swear that they have read, understand, and will abide by the Ingleside City Charter requirements including, but not limited to, the following:

Section 3.02. Qualification of members.

The Mayor and each Councilmember shall be a resident of the City of Ingleside, a qualified voter of the State of Texas, and shall have been a resident of the City of Ingleside for at least a year immediately preceding his/her election.

Section 5.02. Filing for office.

- A. Eligibility to File for Office: Each candidate for an elective position in the City of Ingleside shall meet the following requirements:
1. The candidate shall be a qualified voter of the City of Ingleside and a resident of Ingleside for a period of at least one year prior to the date of election.
 2. At the time of filing for office, the candidate shall not be in arrears in the payment of any taxes or other liabilities due the City.
 3. No candidate may file for more than one office or position per election.
 4. No city employee shall be a candidate for any office while an employee of the City.
- B. Procedure for Filing for Office: Any qualified person (see Section 5.02A) who desires to become a candidate for election shall file an application with the City Secretary not earlier than sixty days, nor later than the thirty-first day prior to the election date or within such other time as may be allowed by Texas Election Code. Such an application shall clearly designate the office to which the candidate seeks election, and shall contain a sworn statement by the candidate that he or she is fully qualified under the provisions of this Charter to hold the office sought
