

ORDINANCE _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY'S TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE SCHEDULE IN ORDER TO ADD AND REMOVE CERTAIN SCHOOL ZONE SIGNS THROUGHOUT THE CITY LIMITS.

Whereas; Well monitored and regulated traffic patterns within a city contributes to safety and an improved quality of life for it's citizens, and,

Whereas; Changing conditions, population trends or other circumstances often contribute to necessary changes in traffic control strategies, and

Whereas; the Ingleside Independent School District has requested ammendments to the "School Zone" signs; and

Whereas; The City of Ingleside may from time to time amend it's traffic control device schedule to better facilitate the smooth and orderly flow of traffic, thereby better serving the public and it's residents, now therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLESIDE, COUNTY OF SAN PATRICIO, STATE OF TEXAS:

Section 62-46 of the city code of ordinances is hereby amended by adding to the city's schedule of traffic control devices by;

Removing "SCHOOL ZONE" signs at/near

- Southbound traffic on Avenue A at/near 4th Street
- Eastbound traffic on 8th Street between FM 1069 and Poinsettia Place
- Eastbound traffic on 5th Street between FM 1069 and Avenue D
- Eastbound traffic on Waco Street at/near Filberto Villa Drive
- Eastbound traffic on 2nd Street at/near FM 1069
- Nourthbound traffic on Avnue I at/near 1st Street

Adding "SCHOOL ZONE" signs at/near

- Westbound traffic on 8th Street at/near Avenue A
- Eastbound traffic on 8th Street at/near Greenbriar Drive
- Northbound traffic on Raintree Trail at/near 4th Street
- Eastbound traffic on Waco Street at/near Coach Emory Bellard Drive
- Southbound traffic on Filberto Villa Drive at/near Waco Street
- Eastbound traffic on 1st Street at/near Avenue J
- Southbound traffic on Big Oak Lane at/near 1st Street

Reading; As provided by Article III, Section 3.11.B of the Charter of the City of Ingleside, this ordinance or the caption of it shall be read at two city council meetings with at least two weeks elapsing between each reading.

Effective Date; As provided by Article III, Section 3.11.C of the Charter of the City of Ingleside, this ordinance shall be effective upon adoption and after publication of this ordinance in its entirety or in summary form once in the official newspaper of the City of Ingleside, San Patricio County, Texas.

Severance; If any part of this ordinance is invalid or void or is declared to be so, then said part shall be severed from the balance of this ordinance and said invalidity shall not affect the balance of this ordinance, the balance of the ordinance to be read as if said invalid or void portion thereof were not included.
