If there are buildings, structures, or residences within 150 feet of the proposed excavation, then a description of such buildings, structures and residences as are within such distance, stating the distance, providing name, mailing address and telephone number of the owner thereof, stating that the owner approves of the excavation, and attach the original of the owner's written permission for the excavation
- Include a positive statement that the proposed excavation shall not block, encumber, or close any public street, way, or alley, or disturb the lateral support thereof.
- Include a positive statement that the proposed excavation shall not be located nearer than 500 feet to any exterior property line boundary of lands utilized for a public or parochial school, a college, a university, a hospital, a church, public building, or a cemetery.
- Include a positive statement that the proposed excavation is not and shall not be in an area which has on public record restrictions or covenants prohibiting such a use of the property.

I have carefully read the foregoing affidavit and swear that all the information included in and with this affidavit is the truth. I have attached a map, survey or drawing showing the location of the excavation. I will also submit any other pertinent data required.
